

# JEUNES TALENTS CIRQUE EUROPE



A programme of artistic support for emerging creators in the contemporary circus field in Europe.

Aimed at assisting artistic research and creation in this field.

## CALL FOR PROJECTS

If you have a new creative project and an interest in developing your career in contemporary circus: you can apply for assistance from Jeunes Talents Cirque Europe.

### CONDITIONS

- There is no age limit.
- Performances that have already been created are not eligible.

#### You must:

- be resident in Europe,
- not be currently studying in a circus school,
- not have already been selected for previous JTC awards

#### You can:

- Applications can be made solo or with several people.
- A legal structure or a formal company is not required.
- It is not necessary to hold a performing art business license.

**The application form must be returned by September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009.**

### SELECTION PROCESS :

#### 1 – Call for Projects – Application forms

Download an application form from the JTCE website or [www.cryingoutloud.org](http://www.cryingoutloud.org) for UK applicants.

Complete and send it back by September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

#### 2 – Application Form:

A committee of professionals will shortlist about thirty projects based on the application forms.

#### 3 – Jury Presentation:

The shortlisted applicants are invited to present their project as a 'work in progress' at one of five European selection meetings. The jury will consist of arts professionals (producers, artists, festival directors) who will select ten projects to receive assistance from JTCE.

#### 4 – Support:

These projects will be awarded support and financial assistance (e.g. artistic residences, mentoring, training, administration and production, financial aid) in a variety of European locations, depending on the needs of the individual projects (between 12,000 to 15,000 euros per project)

#### 5 – Public presentation:

The ten artistic teams will be invited to show the work created at one of the public presentations organized in Europe.
